<u>Smailholm Tower</u>

Smailholm Tower is a <u>peel tower</u> that stands around five miles west of <u>Kelso</u> in the <u>Scottish Borders</u>. Its dramatic situation, atop a crag of Lady Hill, commands wide views over the surrounding countryside. The tower is a <u>Scheduled Ancient Monument</u> in the care of <u>Historic Scotland</u>.
